

ICGI: Poll on sequencing the cotton genome

The one-week survey was held from October 18, 2006 to October 25, 2006 through this website and members were emailed private keys which they then used to cast their vote. **The survey is now closed.**

Ninety-three members responded to the poll on sequencing, and 100% were in favor of sequencing the cotton genome. The preference of genome to sequence was *G. hirsutum* 49 (53%), *G. raimondii* 20 (22%), *G. arboreum* 11 (12%), *G. herbaceum* 9 (10%), and *G. barbadense* 4 (4%).
